

Immunization & Well Visit Schedule

AGE	Procedure
At Birth	Hepatitis B- Newborn Screening
1 week	EXAM
2 weeks	EXAM, if necessary- as decided by the doctor
1 month	EXAM, Developmental Testing
2 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Pentacel (DTap, IPV, Hib) – Hepatitis B – Prevnar – Rotavirus
4 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Pentacel (DTap, IPV, Hib) – Prevnar – Rotavirus
6 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Pentacel (DTap, IPV, Hib) – Hepatitis B – Prevnar
9 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – PPD placement, RETURN TO OFFICE IN 2 DAYS <b>**IF NOT READ, \$20.00 FEE IS ASSESSED FOR REPEAT TESTING**</b>
12 months (1 year)	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Varicella (chicken pox) -- Prevnar –MMR --- Hepatitis A – CBC/Lead screen done at lab.
15 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Hepatitis A, (if needed) -- Pentacel
18 months	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Hepatitis A – Autism screen done
24 months (2 years)	EXAM, Developmental Testing – Hepatitis A (if needed) – CBC/Lead screen done at lab – Autism screen done.
2 ½ years	EXAM, Developmental Testing
3 years	EXAM, Developmental Testing, Catch up on any missed vaccines.
4 years	EXAM – Kinrix (DTaP, IPV) – MMR –Varicella
5 years	EXAM -- Catch up on any missed vaccines
6-10 years	EXAM yearly (as allowed by insurance) Boostrix at 10 Menactra at 10 HPV
11-18 years	EXAM yearly – Counseling for Gardasil BEXSERO given 16-18 Menactra given between 16-18 years
